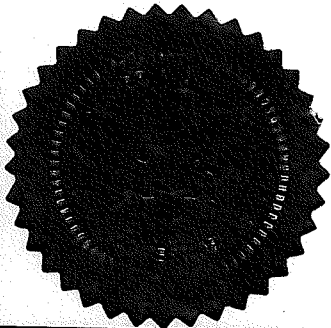


Whereas, Payroll professionals have become increasingly proactive in educating both the business community and the public-at-large about the payroll tax withholding systems; and,
